Candidates who do not hold such a qualification may take a numeracy test set and marked by the university and administered by the employer. Students may provide evidence of this requirement any time until the end of stage two. However, it is recommended that they do so at the time of admission to the course.</p> <p>Hold standard grade 2 or equivalent in English. Where candidates do not hold such a qualification they should successfully complete one of the two first stage courses, either K100 or DD100, before registering. Certain HNC and HND qualifications may permit direct entry to stage 2.</p> <p>Complete a personal statement saying why they want to become a social worker. The statement must be word processed to demonstrate that the candidate can engage with Information Communications Technology (ICT).</p> <p>Obtain a statement of support from their line manager and sponsor.</p> <p>Sign a declaration that they are suitable to register with the SSSC.</p> <p>Meet the requirements of the student specification (please contact university for a copy).</p> <p>Please contact university directly.</p>
