8. Remuneration in Excess of £150k

No Council member or employee of the Scottish Social Services Council received remuneration in excess of £150k. Details of the remuneration of Council members and senior management are published in the Remuneration Report section of the Annual Report and Accounts. The Annual Report and Accounts of the Scottish Social Services Council are also available in this section of the website.

9. Statement on Sustainable Economic Growth

The Scottish Social Services Council (SSSC) is the regulator for the social service workforce in Scotland. Our work means the people of Scotland can count on social services being provided by a trusted, skilled and confident workforce.

We protect the public by registering social service workers, setting standards for their practice, conduct, training and education and by supporting their professional development. Where people fall below the standards of practice and conduct we can investigate and take action.

We:

- publish the national codes of practice for people working in social services and their employers
- register people working in social services and make sure they adhere to our codes of practice
- promote and regulate the learning and development of the social service workforce
- are the national lead for workforce development and planning for social services in Scotland.

The Climate Change (Scotland) Act 2009 sets high targets for Scotland to reduce carbon emissions by 80% in 2050. Public bodies are tasked to support this initiative by reducing their carbon emissions. During 2014-15 the SSSC worked towards implementing its Carbon Management Plan which incorporates specific targets that have been approved by the Carbon Trust. This includes areas such as energy consumption, business travel, sustainable procurement and our working environment.

The SSSC produced its first Carbon Management Plan in 2011, which is now reported on annually. The SSSC is located in Dundee but staff travel throughout Scotland, contributing to the travel emissions.

The SSSC continues to grow and as our remit is Scotland-wide, this has contributed to our increase in travel. We are holding an increasing number of Fitness to Practice hearings which have associated travel costs and many of our staff are travelling to provide training and events throughout Scotland. We also have a growing international reputation - in the last three years there has been an increased interest in our work from overseas and the SSSC has been invited to speak at events and meet decision makers in the USA, Canada, New Zealand and Australia. This aligns with the Scottish Government's vision of Scotland as a world leader.

10. STATEMENT ON EFFICIENCY, EFFECTIVENESS AND ECONOMY

The SSSC, as a growing organisation, must respond to the public sector expenditure pressures by seeking to minimise expenditure growth through efficiency gains. It is only through a commitment to efficiency that the SSSC will be able to instil the confidence necessary to secure the funding we require.

The SSSC has been set budget targets over the three years 2012-13 to 2014-15. These targets are based on a baseline of grant-in-aid for 2011-12 and equate to cuts of 9%, 2% and 2% over the three years. If the SSSC sets its budgets in line with the financial cuts profile (excluding exceptional items) then it will have met the efficiencies expectations over the three year period.

2014-15 Efficiency Assumptions

As with 2013-14 and in line with the Scottish Spending Review 2012-13 to 2014-15, the Sponsor reduced the Grant in Aid (GIA) available to the SSSC by £150k. The Sponsor also agreed to provide additional GIA for 2014-15 to fund the increased resources required to manage the increased Fitness to Practice caseloads and other activity associated with the expansion in the size and scope of the register.

There were a number of cost pressures that had to be absorbed within the overall available funding. This included the costs of staff increments (£88k) and the pay award for 2014-15 (£92k).

The increase in budget between 2012-13 and 2014-15 makes analysing efficiencies potentially difficult. However, the following paragraphs explain the key underpinning efficiencies associated with the increase in activity.

Overall impact of increase in activity

The number of people registering with the SSSC is increasing on a phased basis to the point where it is anticipated there will be 140,000 people registered with the SSSC by 2020. This compares to approximately 55,000 registrants in 2012-13 when the current baseline budget was set.

The outlook for future years is that the SSSC will continue to be a growing organisation until 2020, as the Register will grow substantially over this period. This projected growth in registration numbers and the nature of the workforce coming within the scope of registration are the most influential drivers of the SSSC's resource requirements and need to be reflected in both the SSSC's baseline budgets and efficiency targets.

The SSSC has worked with the Sponsor department over several years in estimating the impact of increasing numbers and changing types of Registrants on the staff and other costs directly involved in the maintenance of the Register. This has been achieved through the use of a registration resource model.

What has become increasingly apparent is the consequential impact this growth in the size and scope of the Register has on other parts of the organisation and most significantly on the fitness to practice and hearings functions.

Looking forward

The increase in the number of registered workers will require the SSSC to expand its workforce but there will be a clear requirement to demonstrate continued efficiencies before making demands on scarce public funding. Based on evidence so far, the Sequence system (our customer relationship and information management IT system) is anticipated to contribute to future efficiency gains and will be the subject of future reports to the Finance and Resources Committee.

The 2014-15 budget assumed that further investment in the Sequence system would deliver registration processing time efficiencies of 19.5% when the 2012-13 planning assumptions are applied to the 2014-15 registration numbers. This has reduced Registration staffing requirements by 15.5FTE based on previous efficiency assumptions and by 34FTE when compared to pre-Sequence planning assumptions. An updated Sequence benefits realisation report was reported to Council in 2014-15.

The SSSC is currently implementing a new payroll/HR system, Pulse, which is also expected to contribute towards future efficiency gains. This will also be the subject of future reports to the Resources Committee.
