

Endorsers for all social service workers

A countersignatory (nominated by your employer and set up with us) must endorse your application.

Current social service employment status	Who can endorse the application
Employed by a statutory, private or voluntary organisation.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A countersignatory for your organisation.
Employed by an employment agency.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A countersignatory for the employment agency you are employed by.
On a secondment from a social service employer.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A countersignatory for the social service organisation you are employed by and not the organisation you are seconded to.
Self-employed.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A person equivalent to a senior representative of a social service employer, such as a senior representative of a social service organisation who purchases or commissions your services.
Employed by two (or more) social services employers.	<p>Two endorsements required:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • a countersignatory for the organisation where most of your time is spent <p>and</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • a countersignatory for one of the additional organisations.
